



Using the Database

Searching for grants can be done by keyword (or keywords), geographic location, subject heading, or any combination of the above. Advanced search tools are also available for the more targeted searches. Additional search parameters include program type, sponsor name, sponsor type, title of grant, deadline, restrictions, requirements and description.

Comprehensive Search Results

Updated daily by direct contact with sponsoring organizations, the GrantSelect database is more than a simple directory. Each record lists detailed information about a grant program, organized so that a user can see at-a-glance if the potential funder is a good fit. The most comprehensive source of available funding opportunities, GrantSelect comprises ten customized segments: **Arts and Humanities, Biomedical and Health Care, Children and Youth, Community Development, PreK-12th Grade and Adult Education, International Programs, Operating Grants for Nonprofit Organizations, Faith-Based Grants, Scholarships & Fellowships, and Special Populations.** Searches can be limited to a specific segment or include all segments for a broader set of search results.

Grant Title 1
Florida Division of Cultural Affairs Organizations Grants--Music

Description 2
The music program is designed to assist Florida music organizations and music service groups to develop their artistic and administrative skills. This program encourages the creation of projects that promote excellence in music performance and strive to bring such excellence to communitywide audiences. This category includes, but is not limited to, such organizations as symphonies, community or youth orchestras, opera companies, community operas, musical theater, chamber or jazz ensembles, choral groups, and community bands. Each category carries its own eligibility criteria in addition to general requirements. A guidelines booklet with application forms must be obtained from the Bureau of Grant Services prior to submitting an application. General program support is for up to 10 percent of the last completed fiscal year's revenue, not to exceed \$50,000; specific project grants to arts organizations is for up to 20 percent of the last completed fiscal year's revenue, not to exceed \$25,000; and specific project grants to nonarts organizations is for up to 10 percent of the last completed fiscal year's revenue, not to exceed \$25,000. Annual deadline dates may vary; contact program staff for exact dates.

Requirements 3
An organization must qualify as a political subdivision of a municipal, county, or state government in Florida; or be a nonprofit, tax-exempt Florida corporation. A dollar-for-dollar match is required, with 25 percent in kind allowed.

Restrictions 4
Organizations applying for general program support may not apply for a specific project grant. Arts organizations that have been incorporated for less than one year are not eligible for general program support.

1. **Grant Title:** The exact title of the grant program.
2. **Description:** A summary of the grant program, the focus and intent of the program and other general information.
3. **Requirements:** Details on who may apply and key information necessary for the application process [i.e., 501(c)(3) status, other tax-free status, etc.].
4. **Restrictions:** Limitations and other information on types of programs/grantees that will not be eligible for the grant award.
5. **Samples:** Grants that have been awarded in the past and to whom.
6. **Deadline:** Date by which the application/proposal must be received or postmarked.
7. **Geographic Restrictions:** Areas in which grantseekers must be located in order to be eligible to receive the grant award.
8. **Contact:** Name, phone number and/or email address of person to contact with questions or more information.
9. **Internet:** The website address of the sponsoring organization's giving program (if available).
10. **Sponsoring Organization:** Name of the organization offering the grant.
11. **Type:** The kind of sponsoring organization, such as private foundation, state agency, etc.
12. **Program(s):** The broad categories of the types of programs that will be sponsored.
13. **Subject(s):** Specific topics in which the sponsoring organization is interested in supporting.

GrantSelect is an extensive online grants database owned and operated by Schoolhouse Partners. It contains information on funding opportunities for faculty, postdoctoral fellows, graduate students, universities and colleges, nonprofit organizations, arts professionals and institutions, educational institutions, service delivery programs, and international professionals and institutions.
